

MEDICAL OUTREACH IN NEBBI 05/03/2020 – 07/03/2020 REPORT

The Outreach was a great experience for the team, as our first partnership with **Edu Child Foundation** in **Nebbi District**. However as part of my mandate I would like to submit the report of our findings and work/ service to the great people of Nebbi District.

First I would like to appreciate Edu Child Foundation and the team that literally became family and part of us (EMOTER), in a special way let me mention names; Joan Onyai, Denis Okurmu, Florence Bbabiye, Liberty Adubango, Hope Cherry Pikwo and Kennedy Mungujakisa.

I would also like to appreciate the EMOTER team; Bob Sobya Kojoo, Nanfuka Betty, Bagobedde Maureen, Mariam Gloria Nambtya, Amaniyo Winnie, I can't forget our slogan each time we woke up in the morning before we prayed "*we are in this together for the people*", thank you.

Our total impact was **2693 people**, in summary **1786 people** got vaccination/prevention services (Vitamin A, De-worming, Measles rubella vaccination, HPV vaccination, and Tetanus vaccination) and **970 people** got medical services that is Laboratory services, consultation services and medication services.

However there were challenges faced in the due course of our services that includes the following;

1. Less/ few medical staffs to accommodate the huge number of people that turn up for the outreach, this caused a lot of delay in service delivery.
2. No dental services, there was a challenge of this since we had a lot of people that turn up with cases that needed attention of a dentist.
3. We also faced a challenge with the transport/ car this delayed our movements to the field hence affecting our time management which is always paramount.
4. Less / shortage of medication like the Probeta – N eye drops, and the clotrimazole cream, we had a lot of children with such challenges and the elderly always turned them down since we ran short of them.
5. Loss of records at the registry, we faced this challenge in that in the end we couldn't tally some names compared to the impact numbers we have

We the above mentioned we would make the following **recommendations**:

1. Making of adjustments on the budget to accommodate/ aid facilitation of more medical staffs for the fort coming outreaches/ activities.
2. Inclusions or addition of dental services, this will aid to the best of the people we service given the survey we got as an alarming problem in the community.
3. On the issue of transportation, we advise for a better car hire in consideration of area of travel and climate of therein.
4. Increase of medical supplies to avoid future shortages during outreaches/ activities, especially the highly used medicines.
5. The issue of record we would like proper orientation of the person doing this, our partners Edu Child would be the best option to take up this to avoid loss of initials.
6. We would advise that a day prior to the activities be dated to training of both teams on how the activities will run and how certain challenges/ emergencies that a raise during the outreach can be handled, this will ensure as well proper organization.
7. Lastly we would recommend for increase of the number days that the activities should last at least from 3days to 5 days, this will aid on proper follow ups on the last outreach done.

Also on this report is the attached copy of how the outreach faired right from day one to day three, a copy of the accountability for management purposes (*strictly confidential*), immunization/ prevention program report and also list of people that turned up for the outreach (*in excel*).




